EVENT ENTRY RULES:

- All fees must be paid in full prior to listed entry deadlines for a given event
- Please read the ground rules for each given event. Certain weekend events are non refundable for events or stalls once entered. (I do not make exceptions for this)
 The office fee and exhibitions are never refundable.
- The office fee is charged each time you submit an application. (I cannot change this on the form) So every time you submit an entry, the office fee will apply.
- All entries are submitted online including the late entries. Most late entries close 1 hour before the
 first race starts each day through the online entry link only. (I do not take onsite entries.)
 But be aware on certain events I may not take late entries at all. Like maybe the NFRP Race so
 make sure to read the information on each event. All checks are mailed out within 3 days of
 event and must be cashed within 90 days. Checks over 90 days will not be reissued.
- All weekend events must be prepaid. The Wednesday night races are pay onsite with cash only.
 But even the Wednesday night races must be entered online.
- I will post the draw for the Wednesday night races directly after 12:00 noon that day. After that time, all fees are due. If you are a no show, you will be invoiced for fees and that must be paid before you can enter another race.
- I will post the draw on Facebook on the "Twisted Turn N Burn" page for the Wednesday night races. The draw for the Weekend events will be posted on the website at www.sbarsarena.com.
- Horse/Rider changes must be done in the office 1 hour prior to the first race start time of the day. But again....read the schedule or rules for each weekend event. Certain weekend events like the NFRP Race I do not allow changes or selling of spots of any kind.
- The draw is a random draw for contestants and horses. No preference will be given to which horse runs first.
- It is your responsibility to know your draw positions and run the correct horse in the correct draw position. Running the wrong horse will result in a disqualification for both horses that this affects.
- You must be ready and trying to get your horse in the arena when your name is called. We do make every effort to give you a fair chance to enter the arena but after a while we may 3 call you. If you have a horse that is hard to get in the arena, please have help available.
- When we are in Pavilion 3 you may make 1 circle before beginning your run unless it is set up as run in and run out. When we are in the Big Arena you must run in and run out.
- We drag every 5 and do a big drag every 50 at the weekend races.
- A horse may not be ridden by more than 1 person in a given event. (Jane may ride Buster in the Open and Sally may ride Buster in the Youth Only but Jane and Sally may not both ride Buster in the Open or both in the Youth.
- Most of our races are drawn up with the Youth and the Open in a combined draw but will be separated in the results. (This may also be different for some of the big weekend races)
- A down barrel or broken pattern is a no time. Contestants may not go around a barrel more than one time. If a contestant is asked to leave the arena, they must leave immediately.
- Exhibitions have a 60 second time limit. Anyone that goes over the time limit when being repeatedly warned will forfeit their next exhibition or may be disqualified from the race.
- A current W9 form must be completed and in our hands before you can receive any payout.
- DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE COMPETITION ARENA

SIDE POTS & YOUTH:

- If also entered into any of the sidepots such Senior, Futurity or Derby....you must also be entered in the Open 5D for that day. You will only run once and your time will carry over.
- If you are entered in the Youth 3D and the Open 5D on a given day....you will only run once and your time will carry over.

DRESS CODE:

- All weekend races will have a dress code unless otherwise stated.
- Long sleeves (Does not have to have a collar or button down
- Jeans
- Cowboy boots with heels
- Cowboy Hats or helmets
- No Ball Caps allowed
- If you lose a hat inside the arena, you must pay the barrel setter \$5 to get it back.

STALLS:

 When available for our use, stalls on dirt will go to first to enter & pay for both nights. If wanting to stall by a friend you must put all stalls on your form so they can be together. I will not save stalls.
 They are assigned as contestants enter. No overnight tie outs or outside shavings are allowed.
